Schedule Information:

- Students must remain in their classrooms for the duration of the exam block in order to maintain the integrity of all assessments and provide optimum opportunity for success for all students.
- Health Screening will be conducted before entering the building. [Face Covering Guidelines](#) must be followed by staff and students.
- [Guidelines for Cleaning and Disinfecting](#) must be followed between exam sessions; teachers must clean and disinfect surfaces, supplies, materials and equipment used by students before allowing another group of students to use them.
- Teacher-made exams will be administered virtually. Teacher made exams that are project, portfolio, or performance based may be largely completed prior to the exam window opening, and that is permissible. Final exam projects (assignment sheets and rubrics) must be submitted to Ms. Keefer by
- Teacher made exams must be consistent at a PLT level.

- Accommodations included in a student's IEP and/or Online Instruction Service and Support Plan (OISSP), 504 Plan, and/or EL Plan must be provided when administering teacher made exams virtually.
- The "5 day rule" for semester courses still applies. This state rule says that both teacher made and state exams must be given within that time period.
- NC Test Tutorial will be provided prior to testing.
- WCPSS will provide transportation to students who are participating in face-to-face exams on the day(s) they are scheduled to test.
- Students cannot be exempt from required state testing except through the medical exemption process. For the 2020-2021 school year, seniors who have a final grade of C or better will be exempt from teacher made exams.
