STAGGERED ENTRY DATES/ QUICK OVERVIEW

As the school year approaches, many kindergarten families seek to understand more about the Staggered Entry process. This process encourages a gradual transition from home to school. All Wake County kindergarteners participate in the Staggered Entry Week beginning August 28th. During this first week, Kindergarteners will come to school one day only (Monday, August 28th, Tuesday, August 29th, Wednesday, August 30th, Thursday, September 1st, and Friday, September 2nd).

via email the second week in August! On your child's assigned day, he or she will be in school for the full day. Students will not be marked absent for the days they do not attend this week.

ARRIVAL/ DISMISSAL/ TRANSPORTATION FOR STAGGERED ENTRY

You may arrive as early as 8:45 AM and our day will begin at 9:15 AM. Please be sure you are here on time. Please arrive to pick up your child at 3:45 PM. If your child is riding the bus, please make sure you have registered your child for transportation. You can find this information on our website or the WCPSS Transportation site:

Please be prepared to let the teacher know how your child will be returning home at the end of the staggered entry day, and if he or she brought lunch or will be purchasing it. Each child will need to bring a snack every day, including their assigned Staggered Entry day.

STUDENT ACTIVITIES ON STAGGERED ENTRY DAYS

On the Staggered Entry day, your child will have the opportunity to interact with other kindergarten students in both large and small group situations. The students will tour the school and spend time with our Enhancement teachers (Art, Music, PE). We will also explain routines, procedures, define expectations, and have time for some fun! The kindergarten team will work to gather information they need to make your child's year positive, rewarding, and differentiated to meet individual needs of all students. This day also allows kindergarten students to experience their first day in a smaller, less overwhelming environment.

TEACHER ASSIGNMENTS/ MEET THE TEACHER EVENT

On **September 1st**, you are invited to attend our "**Kindergarten Meet the Teacher**" event from **10:00-11:00 AM**. This will be a time for your family to meet your child's wonderful teacher, see the classroom, and really get a sense of what to expect when your child returns to school on **Tuesday, September 5th**. We will begin on Tuesday due to the Labor Day Holiday on Monday. You will also be able to register for our FVES Before/ After School program, join our outstanding PTA, buy spirit wear, register for a carpool tag, and ask questions regarding bus or cafeteria with respective staff. Please note that we do not have a walker zone for our school. All neighborhoods have a bus route assigned to them and areas around our school are not safe for walkers in the busy traffic. Please make sure students are brought and picked up from school by way of carpool, bus, childcare van, or vendor transportation assigned by Special Education services.

TRANSITION TIPS

- Talk it up: Let your child know how great kindergarten is going to be and how excited you are for them! Discuss with your child what to expect in the first week of school: singing, reading, drawing, counting, meeting new friends and teachers, and visiting the playground and lunchroom!
- Be prepared: Have supplies and procedures for arrival and dismissal ready so your child does not worry about the materials or way they will get home!
- Arrival: We recommend that you drop your child off in his/her classroom on their staggered entry day and on September 6th if possible. After that first day, we encourage you to drop off in the carpool loop or use the bus. We ask that kindergarten students walk to and from their classroom without parents after this day. We will have many staff members ready and willing to ensure your child gets to the correct classroom! Bus transportation routes will be posted as soon as they are released from the county on our school website. Please call our main office with any questions!

ARRIVAL/ DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Carpool students are to be dropped off between 8:45 AM and 9:15 AM and be picked up from 3:45-4:05 PM in the carpool lane. Each carpool student will receive a carpool decal to hang in their car and students will have an assigned carpool number. Please assist your child in learning their carpool number. We ask that drivers adhere to our safety procedures, which include moving in a single file through the carpool lane (not in the bus lane) and parking only in the designated parking lots when needed. Please refrain from using your cellphone and from using all tobacco products while driving through the carpool lane and while on campus in the car. Please do not park in the handicapped parking spots unless you have a handicapped parking decal. It is also very important not to send students unaccompanied through any

REMINDERS




