### Scholarship:

The SRMHS Engineering Academy Scholarship recognizes a student who exemplifies our motto of **"Forging New Generations of Engineers and Scientists".** The recipient will embody the principles of the Engineering Academy and typify great academic promise in pursuing a higher education in engineering or an engineering related field as demonstrated by academic and internship experience as well as extracurricular activities.

#### Award:

Scholarships may be awarded in the amounts of \$1,000 for a 4 year accredited college **or** \$500 for a 2 year accredited college or technical program. The scholarship is non-renewable.

### **Qualifications:**

To qualify for the Engineering Academy Scholarship an applicant must:

- be a current senior Southeast Raleigh Magnet High School enrolled in the Engineering Academy;
- have a minimum of 2.75 GPA (unweighted).

### **Selection Criteria**:

Applications will be judged on the basis of:

- Statement of Interest
- Panelist interview

#### **Requirements:**

**ALL** requirements must be met for the application to be considered.

- Submit the completed scholarship application form
- Submit Statement of Interest (Refer to Section II on the application)
- Participate in the interview session to be scheduled in April 2019
