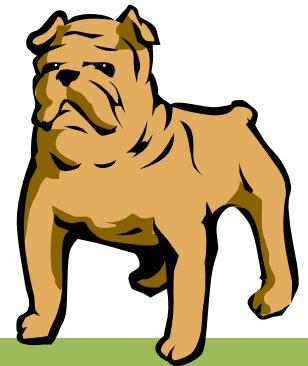

Registration Timeline

February 2

Registration forms distributed to students in seminar

February 6 - 27

Course registration location is Student Services CDC, by scheduled appointments (explanation)

March 24

Course request verification forms given to students to take home, review and acquire parent/guardian signatures.

March 27

ALL course request verification forms are turned in to seminar teachers

Steps to Course Selection

➤ All course selections must be made on the course selection sheet:

➤ Step 1: choose your elective courses

➤ Step 2: Rank your elective selections in the order of importance example:

1. Modern Dance Beginning
2. Food 1
3. Team Sports II &
4. Magnet Digital Arts

*****You will receive a copy an unofficial transcript to review when making selections, certain classes require a pre-requisite in order to register for the next course offering.**

Class Selection Guidelines

- Make sure you are satisfied with your course choices
- Remember if you are assigned to one of your alternate classes, you will remain in that class.
- Changing classes once you receive your schedule will not be allowed



Is This What I Want...?

- **Make informed choices!**

What are my interests & educational goals?

- **Use your transcript to determine which credits you have earned**

- Review graduation requirements & consult your guardian(s) & counselor



Other things to consider...



- Consider your overall course load when selecting your classes
- Challenge yourself & consider Honors and AP courses. Don't settle for doing OK but don't choose too many if you aren't prepared to work hard
- AP classes require signed contracts, once selected, you will remain in that selected course
- Most AP classes require summer assignments which may be required to be turned in on the first day of each school semester

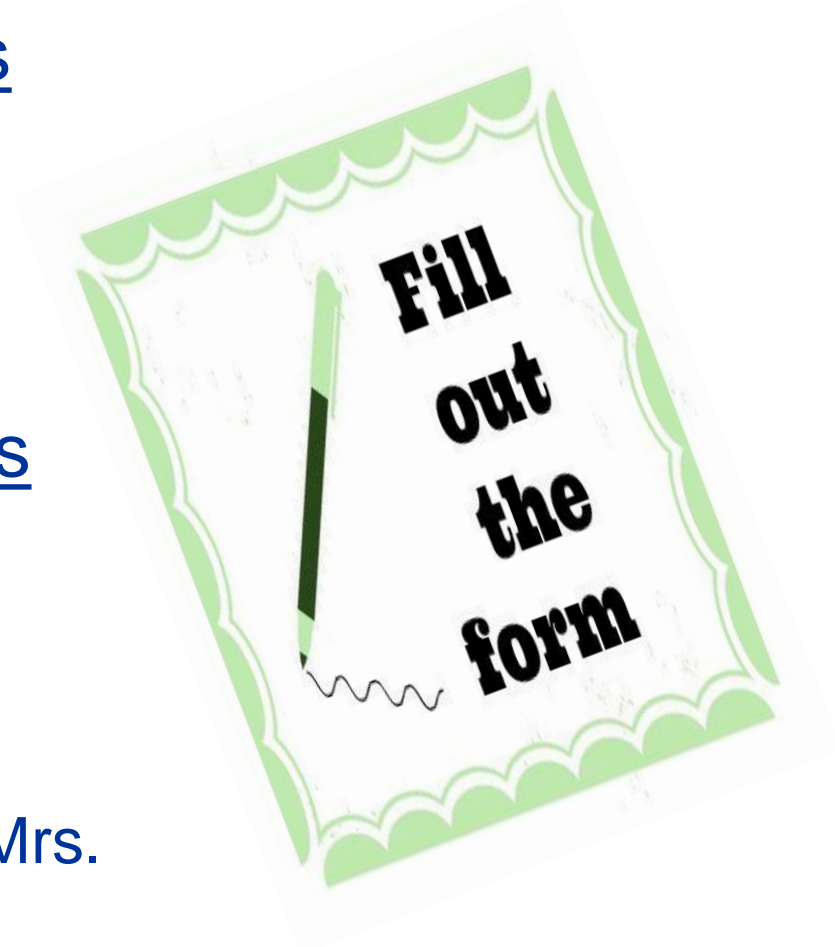
