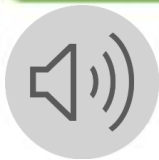

- 1 – Healthful Living
- 2 – electives from Arts, CTE, or World Languages
- 8 electives

UNC System Minimum Admission Requirements

- In addition to the WCPSS graduation requirements, the UNC system universities require....
 - A math higher than Math 3 (i.e., Math 4, HN PreCalculus, AP Statistics)
 - 2 years of the **same** World Language
 - 2.5 weighted gpa OR 1010 SAT or 19 ACT***

***Pandemic Provision: Due to COVID-19, the UNC Board of Governors modified the admissions requirements for first-time freshmen for Spring 2021, Summer 2021, and Fall 2021. The student must still take the SAT or ACT to be considered for admission. For specific details:

College Admission Tests

SAT

- Register @ www.collegeboard.org
- Max score: 1600
- Essay is optional
- No penalty for guessing
- 3 sections
- Test fee waivers are available for eligible students

ACT

- Register @ www.act.org
- Max score: 36 for composite and each section
- No penalty for guessing
- 5 sections
- Test fee waivers are available for eligible students

RDS & FAFSA

Residency Determination Services

- Students seeking admission and in-state tuition at NC colleges/universities must complete the RDS
- Your login is the same as your CFNC.org login
- Also requires parental information



Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- Used by colleges/universities to determine your eligibility of the various forms of financial aid.
- Requires your parents' tax information
- Every student is encouraged to complete the form.
- Application opens on Oct. 1st.
- Create your FSA ID [Log In | Federal Student Aid](#)
- Ms. Winters, financial aid access counselor, will be available starting October 1st.

The Gates Scholarship

- **Eligibility requirements:**

- High school senior
- From at least one of the following ethnicities: African American, American Indian/Alaska Native*, Asian/Pacific Islander American, and/or Hispanic American
- Pell-eligible
- A US citizen, national, or permanent resident
- A minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)
- Additionally, a student must plan to enroll full-time, in a four-year degree program, at a US accredited, not-for-profit, private or public college or university.
