Registration Timeline

January 19-22

Receive registration information and instructions in LA

February 2-26

Counselors meet with students through English classes to assist with course selections

March 24

Students will receive a course verification letter to review and make changes to selections

Course Selection Guidelines

- >Students should utilize the course selection worksheet to plan their selections.
- >All selections will be made in the student's PowerSchool/Homebase account during class sessions with the counselors.
- >Students must choose 8 primary classes and 4 alternate classes

Primary = FIRST CHOICE "I want this class!"

Alternate = "I'll take this course if my first choice isn't available."

Class Selection Guidelines

Make sure you will be satisfied with <u>any</u> combination of classes.



- ➤ If you receive one of your alternate classes, you will be <u>expected</u> to stay in the class
- >Changing classes once you receive your schedule will not be allowed.



Things to Think About...

- >Make informed choices!
- >What are your abilities, interests, educational goals?
- >Use your transcript and HOMEBASE account to determine which credits you have earned
- Review graduation requirements which are posted on the school's website




Things to Think About...



- ➤ Consider your overall course load when selecting your classes
- Challenge yourself and consider Honors and AP courses. BUT...don't choose too many advanced courses if you aren't prepared to work hard or have too many obligations
- >AP classes require a contract. The contract must be signed and you will be expected to stay in the class
- ➤ Most AP classes require summer assignments. Be prepared to have assignments completed by the first day of class.

Teacher Recommendations



- >Pay attention to your teachers' recommendations for your next level of classes. Recommendations are valuable!
- If you and your parents choose to take a class for which you were not recommended, you must complete the <u>WAIVER FORM</u> (found online).
- If you waive into a class, you will be expected to stay in the class so consider very carefully before choosing to do this.

Review your class selections with your <u>parent(s) or</u> <u>guardian(s)</u> to ensure you are selecting classes to meet graduation requirements and plans for life after high school
