Helpful Tips for Seniors: SRMHS Class of 2017

*Our School Code is <u>343239</u> (CEEB/SAT/ACT)

- Attend your senior conference and consult with your counselor as needed.
- Use your **legal** name on all documents. It should be the same name listed on your **birth certificate**. **Do not** use nicknames or abbreviations. **Print and/or save copies** of all documents and correspondence.
- Mark your calendar!!! Attend the WCPSS College Fair on Sunday, September 18th at the NCSU McKimmon Center. Registration NOW at www.gotocollegefairs.com.
- If you plan to apply to 4-year colleges and universities, take one or both **college** admissions tests, the SAT and ACT (with Writing). Register at www.collegeboard.org (SAT) and www.actstudent.org (ACT)
- Students with financial need may be eligible for a waiver of the test fee for the SAT and/or ACT. See Mrs. Orr, Guidance Technician/Receptionist for eligibility information.
- **Use CFNC** (<u>www.cfnc.org</u>) to apply to NC colleges/universities, request transcripts, prepare for admissions tests, research financial aid, and explore careers.
- If you will be a first-generation college student, use www.imfirst.org as a resource.
- Check all deadlines carefully; complete and submit college applications early. You **do not** have to wait to receive your test scores to apply. Colleges will ask for additional information if needed.
- If you need a letter of recommendation or a form completed, give your teacher or counselor at <u>least 3 weeks advance notice</u>. Create a resume and give a copy to the person(s) who will provide a recommendation for you.
- Search all resources for scholarships, starting with the school website. **Do not** pay anyone to complete a scholarship search for you; this information is available FREE online!
- You and a parent should register for a FSA ID for the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The 2017-18 FAFSA will be released on October 1st. Apply for financial aid early!

- Complete the FAFSA regardless of the family's economic status. This information is also used by colleges to determine school based, merit, and federal aid.
- SRMHS has an ACCESS Financial Aid Advisor available one day a week from October to May to assist with financial aid questions. Appointments can be made at 856-2850.
- Some colleges will also require that you complete the *CSS Profile* for merit based and institutional aid. Check with your prospective colleges.
- Complete the NCAA Eligibility form (<u>www.eligibilitycenter.org</u>) if you are intending to play sports at the collegiate level.
- SAT, ACT, and AP exam scores should be requested **directly from these testing agencies**. They <u>are not</u> included on your transcript or sent by the high school to colleges.
