GRADUATION PROJECT: TWO OPTIONS

Traditional:

- Pairs with Junior research paper
- Requires a mentor
- Included a Portfolio
- Included a Product
- •15minute informational presentation

Service Learning:

- Good option for students without a well developed research paper
- Requires volunteer or job shadow hours
- Requires volunteer of shadow location
- •Included Portfolio
- 15minute reflective presentation with student artifacts of time spent

PRODUCTS AND ARTIFACTS

Traditional:

- 15 hours of work that directly relates to student's research and development of product
- •Product Examples:
- Tangible Products
- Fundraisers
- Research Seminars

Volunteer/ Job shadow

- •15 hours of volunteer time/ job shadow that directly relates to issue or job selection
- Student may complete an internship, community service, or job shadow
- •Students must document experience: Video, Scrapbook, Lesson Plans, Interactive presentation with judges

GRADING PROCESS

Student will present to a panel of faculty and guests for a pass/fail credit required for graduation
