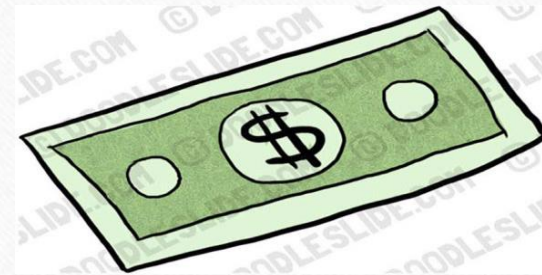

- Visit campus, attend Open House, and orientation

CFNC Launches New College Admissions Application System in August 2016

What does this mean for you?

1. **5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 18** – the current CFNC application system will shut down, and applications not submitted before this change will not be transferred to the new system. You will not be able to start or send applications until the new CFNC application system is available on Monday, August 22nd.
2. **8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 22** – the new CFNC application system is available, and you can start and submit new applications on the new system.
3. **Your application history** – you will still be able to view a list of any admission applications you have submitted before this change, and colleges will still have access to applications you submitted before this change.
4. **Your transcript requests** – transcript requests to colleges are not affected by this change and will be processed normally.

- You must have your name, birthdate, student ID number, and school listed correctly in your CFNC profile for this to work
- This is how you will have your transcript sent to any college in North Carolina that participates in CFNC

More on Sending Transcripts

- If you apply to a college using the Common Application, your transcript will be attached to the School Report form completed online by your counselor.
- If you need your transcript sent to an out of state or other non-CFNC college, or to an employer, the military, or a scholarship program, you will have to order it online through the WCPSS website. There is a link in the lower right corner of our school website under Quick Links.
- The first 3 transcripts you request through WCPSS are free. After that, they cost \$10 each. In some cases, an unofficial copy may be acceptable. You can make photocopies of the one we give you!

Requesting Transcripts

*All requests for transcripts and student records must be done online through the Wake County Public School System website or CFNC. **No** requests are handled at the school level, by phone, or email.*

Wake County Public Schools only authorizes the upload of electronic transcripts to the Common Application. Therefore, students using SENDeDu or any other organization requesting an upload will still have to request a transcript be sent to those colleges using the transcript request policy outlined below.

Current SRMHS Students:

For in-state colleges and universities:

1. Go to www.cfnc.org
2. Log into your CFNC account
3. Go to Transcript Manager
4. Select the schools that you want to receive a transcript and submit.

For out-of-state colleges and universities, scholarships, private organizations, NCAA, Coaches:

1. Go to : <https://wcpss.scriborder.com/>
2. On the left side menus, click the link for current students.
3. Complete the online form.
4. The first three (3) requests are free. After your third request, there is a \$10.00 charge.

Transcript Manager

The Transcript Manager allows public high school students in North Carolina to electronically request their official high school transcript and submit it with their application when applying online through CFNC.org.

The Transcript Manager also lets students track their submitted transcripts. They can view the date their transcript was sent, the confirmation number of their transcript request, and the status of their transcript. Through the Transcript Manager, students can also verify that their transcript has been received by a particular college or university.

In order to send electronic transcripts, you must:

- Be currently enrolled, or enrolled at the time of graduation, at a [participating public high school](#) in North Carolina.
- Make sure you have entered the following information in the [This is Me](#) section of Your Profile:
 - First and Last name - This must match your NC SID name (use the name that appears on your report card, or check with your high school counselor).
 - NC Student Number (formerly NCWISE Student ID) - This can also be found on your report card.
 - E-mail address
 - Gender
 - Date of birth
 - My Account is connected to (the high school where you are currently enrolled, or were enrolled at the time of graduation)

If these conditions are met, you are ready to proceed to the Transcript Manager. A successfully requested transcript should be received by the college within 1-2 business days.

General Information

The Wake County Public School System is now offering a secure site for current and former students to access transcripts, attendance, and employment verifications.

Per District policy and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) student records are only available to those who have authorization from the student or parent, guardian or responsible person if the student is less than 18 years of age. If the student is 18 years of age or older, school records will not be released to a parent, guardian, or responsible person without the student's written consent.
