During an after school workshop JTP taught teachers how to use tableau (frozen pictures made with your body) to communicate meaning and understanding of core content

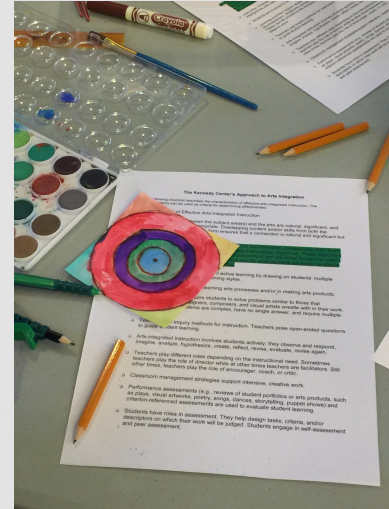


JTP provided EM3 with teaching artists who worked with sixth graders in Social Studies classes. Students connected Drama to World Religion

The Kennedy Center



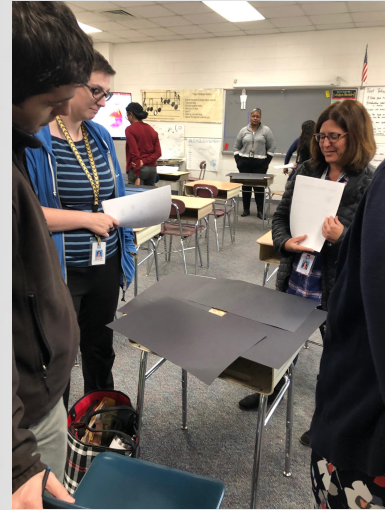
