## **Interim Reports**

Interim reports will be distributed approximately four weeks into each quarter. Students will need to have these interims signed by a parent/guardian and returned by the date listed. #### **PowerSchools**

WCPSS has an online program that enables parents and students to check grades. You can also view student information including attendance and discipline. All student login information from 7<sup>th</sup> grade transfers with them to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parents can create their own login by following the link to PowerSchool from the LRMS website. This resource is updated weekly and is the best way to get frequent academic information.

## **Hornet Team Expectations**
