

BYOD for Kids

- 1. You are responsible for keeping your device safe. No one at the school or county board is responsible for a lost, stolen, or damaged device. It is your responsibility.
- 2. Use skins, decals, or labels to make it easy to know which device is yours.
- 3. You must use the school's Wi-Fi. You may NOT use 3G or 4G at school. If you abuse this rule you will be subject to disciplinary action. We will teach you how to access our Wi-Fi.



- 4. You will never be required to bring your device to school.
- 5. Your device must stay in your backpack at all times unless your teacher gives you permission to use it for learning.



- 6. You may not use your device at lunch, during class changes, restrooms, recess or during dismissal. The device should be in your backpack.
- 7. Your device must be on silent mode at all times unless being used for learning with your teacher's permission.



- 8. Your device may not be used to cheat on assignments or tests.
- 9. You may not use your device to make phone calls, instant message or text.
- 10. You may not take pictures or videos of anyone at school unless your teacher is supervising you. If you break this rule you will be subject to disciplinary action.
- 11. You may not play any games on your device unless they are part of your teacher's assignment.
- 12. You may not print from your device at school.
- 13. You may not connect your device to any network cable outlet or computer in the school.
- 14. Charge your device before you bring it to school. You may not charge your device at school.
- 15. You must follow any other rules or procedures your teacher may set up for your classroom.
- 16. You may not use your device on the school bus.
