Regarding COVID-19, I am following all guidelines and recommendations from WCPSS Leadership. WCPSS has shared that the district will be sharing all current information with families as soon as possible.

From guidance from WCPSS, in collaboration with district leadership and health officials, we have been advised to cancel all events with outside guests over 100 people. This has been advised to potentially prevent the spread of illness. For this reason, we have cancelled the following event:
