## **Greetings Lake Myra Family,**

Families who requested **Virtual Academy for 2021-22** will receive a confirmation letter on May 12<sup>th</sup>. Families that put their name on the waitlist after the deadline are not guaranteed acceptance to the Virtual Academy.

The State Health Department recently provided guidance for **mask wearing when outside**. Students will no longer be required to wear masks when outside, including recess and arrival and dismissal. They will continue to be required to wear a mask in the school and on all school transportation. If a student wants to wear a mask outside, they may.

We have had many students arriving to school after 9:15 when the bell rings. Morning Meeting begins for all students at that time. It is important for your child to participate at this time to be connected to their classroom. Thank you for your attention to this. We dismiss at 4:00 pm. Next year we will be dismissing at 3:45 pm.

If you are leaving WCPSS please plan to **return your child's device to Lake Myra** on June 21<sup>st</sup> when the year ends. Also, any students with a hotspot that was provided by WCPSS will need to return this as well, even if remaining in the district. They will be deactivated at the end of the school year.

On Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup> we will need all students who are in Plan A, in-school instruction, to bring their WCPSS device to school that day with the power cord. All devices are needed for End-of-Grade testing. Your child's device will remain at school and then returned on June 11<sup>th</sup> when testing is complete. Virtual Academy students do not need to bring in their devices on this date.

An online **Virtual Book Fair** will take place May 3-16<sup>th</sup> online. More information will be coming from the PTA.
