We will make all attempts to provide consistency, however, we may have to make modifications. Classroom assignments will be included in acceptance letters for Virtual Academy. If your child is returning to face-to face- from Virtual Academy, we will contact you with your new classroom assignment. The classroom teacher will reach out to you as well. This may not happen until early January.
