



7.21.2020 -- Plan B Transition

- Students begin the school year with full online instruction
- WCPSS will monitor trends with COVID data from state and local health leaders to determine when it can be possible to have student groups report to schools for in-person instruction.

Plan B – Blended Instruction

Students experience combination of in-person instruction at school and online instruction.

Students will attend school for in-person instruction in a small group. Siblings will be in the same groups.

Groups will attend school in a rotation of one week at school and two weeks of online instruction.

Social distancing and health screenings will occur at school daily.

WCPSS Virtual Academy

- Students remain part of Pleasant Grove Elementary.
- Students will follow a daily schedule of activities using an online learning platform for recorded and live instruction from teachers.
- Students participate in the Virtual Academy for at least the fall semester (until the end of January).
- Allows students and families continuity of instruction

1. All students will have the same grading structures.

Transportation Options with in-person learning

- Carpool
- School Bus

Transportation: For In-Person Learning

Request a carpool tag from Front Office.

Submit request for bus transportation from WCPSS District Website

Make arrangements with a Daycare for transportation

Transportation Tags for In-Person Learning

- Issued for all students designated for bus service
- Indicates how child dismisses from school
- Includes name, emergency contact, bus route & stop location
- Kindergarten students issued red tags

Transportation

- Staff work diligently to ensure students go home the same way each day, unless we receive a note from you
- Families should notify school by 9:30 AM each day if your child's transportation will change. This is usually done by sending a note to your child's teacher

Transportation

- WCPSS will provide families with information about bus routes and bus stops in August.
- Students are only allowed to ride their assigned bus and dismiss at their assigned stop.
- All Kindergarten - 1st Grade students must be met at bus stop by an adult.

Transportation

- Students who arrive at school after 9:15 AM are considered late
- No student check-out after 3:15 PM

Medications

- Medications require a doctor's order
- (WCPSS 1702 Form)
- Form available on WCPSS district website
- Medications must be brought into school and signed by an adult



COVID-19 Health Screening

- Daily health screenings will occur for in-person learning
- Students should be screened at-home, before riding school transportation, and when arriving to school.
- Students and adults who are sick or not feeling well should stay home

What to Expect?

1. WCPSS Device Distribution
2. Parent Orientation Sessions
3. Gradual release practice/modeling
4. No Staggered Entry

Your Child's Teacher

- Teachers will be paired with a “buddy teacher”
- Students will be matched with a primary teacher and will also work with their “buddy teacher” for specific activities

Your Child's Teacher

Teacher A: Begins the day with Literacy

Teacher B: Begins the day with Math

Teachers swap groups later in the day

What is consistent?

- Students receive focused instruction. This allows teachers to get to know your child's academic skills better.
- Students learn school routines and digital skills
- Teachers can optimize instruction and activities to engage students in learning.

Key Points to Remember

- You will receive communication in August regarding your child's buddy teachers
- Teachers will connect with families about a virtual "Meet the Teacher" event and other opportunities

Instruction



Online Instruction

- Due to COVID-19, online instruction will be part of your child's learning this year.
- Teachers will use Google Classroom and Google Meet to engage students in live instruction and non-live activities
- Digital tools for building literacy skills and math reasoning will also be used

Online Instruction

- Teachers will meet virtually with students in small groups throughout each week for lessons and guided practice
- Students and families will receive support with using digital tools
- Teachers will communicate with families to establish schedules for online instruction




