Your signature indicated that you have read, understand, and agree with all points mentioned.

Evenings and Weekends: Students on the yearbook staff will need to spend a minimum of one hour working on the publication after school (as needed) in the evening and on weekends, especially as deadlines approach.

Selling: The yearbook publication is considered a small business that must raise its own revenue to pay for printing, supplies. And some equipment. Part of the curriculum covers all aspects of advertising, from copy to soliciting ads. A portion of the student grade is based on their attempts to solicit advertisements. Sales will occur in the summer and the first two grading periods of the school year.

Deadlines: Failure by a student to meet section/layout deadlines can delay printing, cost money for overtime production and jeopardize delivery dates. Missing deadlines can result in a failing grade and/or removal from the class.

Motivated Individuals: Students are expected to possess the self-confidence and assurance, speaking and writing skills necessary to conduct intelligent and professional interviews with a variety of people on and off campus.
