Constraints:


1. Activity must include all parts.
2. Activity must be made with recycled materials.
3. Activity must come with directions if needed.
4. Activity must explain why it would attract tourists.
5. All parts must fit into a boot shoe box or smaller. :)

Ask: What are some things you love to do? What attracts you to go visit other places?

Imagine: What are some ways we can help people in need?

Plan: Develop an activity that would make tourists want to join in on the fun. Create it out recycled materials. Make sure it fits in the proper size box.
