February 16th: PHMS Rising 9th Grade Parent Meeting: The Nuts and Bolts of the High School Transition 9-10 am and 1-2 pm (Please see attached flier)

February 22nd – February 28th: WCPSS Transfer Period (If you are requesting your child attends a school other than your assigned base school. Please see the WCPSS website for more information. The date of notification for transfer requests is March 8th.)

February 27-March 24: High School Registration (The counselors will be conducting classroom guidance lessons with all 8th grade students during February to create a 4 year high school plan, to explain the registration process, and to help them with course selection.
