General Information:

- 1. Doors open at 8:00 am and all campers must be picked up by 5:30 pm. We do not offer any before or after camp care.
- 2. Parents will enter through the side door near the cafeteria for drop off and pick up.
- 3. We have free time from 8:00 8:45 and from 5:00 5:30 each day. Mini iPads, board games and art supplies are available for campers' use.
- 4. We have a "Quiet Time" time each day. Students may bring books, electronic devices, etc. clearly marked with their names.
- 5. Campers will be given t-shirts and need to wear them on field trip days (Wednesdays and Fridays).

- 7. Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunch. We cannot provide refrigeration or microwave.
