Students who receive in-person learning in our regional SPED programs, Preschool, Kindergarten, First, Second, and Third Grades will attend for daily in-person learning Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Friday of this week.

Students in Grades 4 and 5 who receive in-person learning on Cohort A (Group 1) will attend school Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Friday of this week.

All other students (Virtual Academy and Grades 4 and 5 Cohorts B and C) will complete remote learning Mon, Tues, Thurs, and Friday of this week.

Year-Round Calendar for 2021-2022

This is the <u>approved Multi-Track Year Round Calendar for next school year 2021-2022</u>. This calendar assumes we will return in-person on multi-tracks next year. Please note this calendar is subject to change.

AM Carpool Drop-Off and Health Screen Reminders

Carpool drop off is speeding up - thank you!!! Our goal is to have all students screened and in the building before the 9:15am tardy bell.

If you arrive after 9:15am, please walk with your child to the door and wait with them while they are screened.

• On chilly mornings, <u>turn off the heat</u> in your vehicle as you approach the carpool "loop". A warm car will give an elevated temperature reading. If this occurs, you will be asked to pull over and park for your child's temperature to be taken again (with time between readings) before being allowed

into the building. With three failed attempts, your child will not be permitted for in-person instruction that day.

- Have your child sit on the passenger side of the vehicle.
- Students should have their belongings organized and, in their lap, or hands. Please help your student be ready to exit once the health screening procedure is complete.

Did a student go home sick? All household members must also go home

If a WCPSS student (or employee) does not pass the health screening or if they stay home or are sent home because they are experiencing a symptom of illness, their household members must also stay home. This means that any WCPSS student or employee living in the same house must quarantine for 14 days. The household members may return sooner than 14 days if the person experiencing a symptom of illness receives confirmation of an alternate diagnosis or a negative PCR/Molecular test.
