Broughton Fusion Jazz Band/Dance Concert

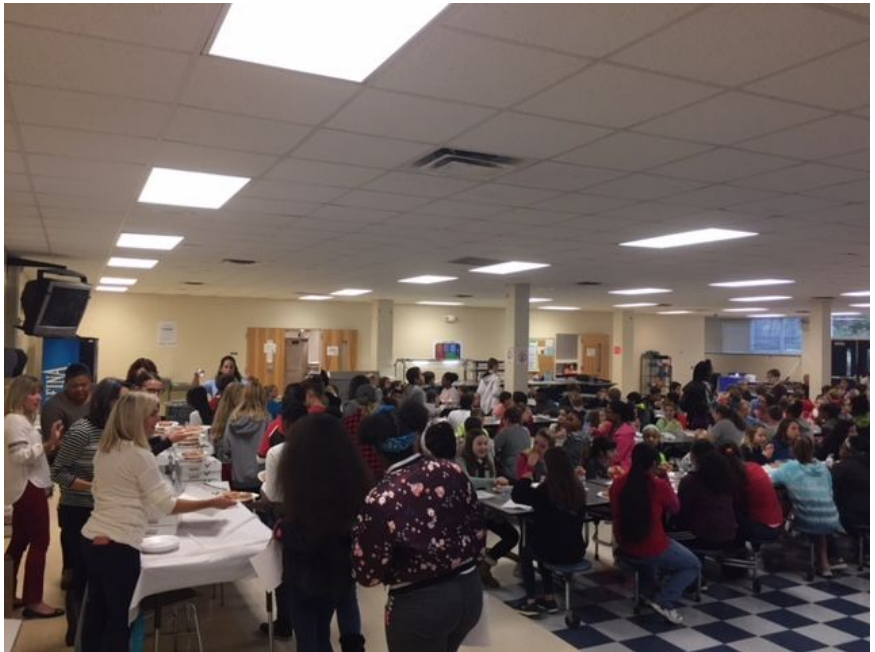
On November 19th five of our dancers and our Jazz Band will be participating in Broughton's Fusion Concert. The Concert begins at 3:30 in the auditorium.

Carpool

Signs of Suicide (SOS)

SOS is a research based suicide prevention program geared for middle school students. The main message of the program is to ACT: Acknowledge, Care and Tell. Acknowledge - That you are seeing signs of suicide in friends and that it is serious. Care - Let your friend know that you are worried about him or her, and that you are concerned that he or she needs help you cannot provide. Tell - A responsible adult, wither with your friend or on his or her behalf. Seventh grade students will be bringing home a letter with more information next Friday. The Marlins team will be the first to go through the program,

starting Tuesday, November 7th. Please contact student services with additional questions.
