

#### **Opening Ceremony:**


Welcome: "Welcome to our February Circle. We have EXCEL rules. EXCEL is really an acrostic. <u>Engaged</u>, eXemplify Respect, <u>C</u>hoose to be Responsible, <u>E</u>stablish Safety, and <u>L</u>ead. We would like for you to create your own acrostic for EXCEL." After the students write the acrostic for EXCEL,

have the students go around in the circle and share their responses.

#### Values: (If you have done circles before)

Place the values that were written in the last circle. Do a round asking, "Are there any questions about the values we wrote."

#### Values: (If this is your first circle)



Every person has an index card and pen. The facilitator will ask students "What do you value in a friend? What do you need to feel safe in order to share in the circle?" Students will write their responses on the cards.

Once it seems like everyone has finished, begin by sharing your values and why they are important. Place your card in the middle and pass the talking piece to your right. Students will share their values and why they are important.

#### **Guidelines:**

The facilitator will go over these guidelines and then ask if there is anything else that the group wants added to the guidelines. Once everything has been added, pass the Talking Piece around to have students agree to the guidelines.

#### Rounds

Each teacher will have 2 papers with the EXCEL expectations for each of the areas. Read aloud the poster before asking each of the questions. Students can also pass the papers around the circle as the answer each of the questions.

#### Round 2:


Looking at the EXCEL expectations for the Bathroom, what is one rule that you think we really need and how do you think the students at Daniels follow it?
