

Magnet Applications

The magnet application deadline has been extended to February 5th. Notification of results is February 19th.

 5th and 8th grade students who wish to continue at a magnet middle or high school MUST apply. All students rising into 6th and 9th grades are initially assigned to their base school and MUST apply if they want to continue at a magnet school at the next level. There are no automatic feeds from magnet elementary to magnet middle or magnet high.

Magnet students who apply to the middle/high school in the same pathway have the highest priority (after siblings) to be selected. Magnet students also have a high priority if they apply to a magnet middle/high in a different pathway. Students selected as part of the choice plan and base students have priority only to the pathway school.

2. Entry grade siblings - those rising into kindergarten, 6th or 9th grade - **MUST** apply to attend a magnet school with an upper grade sibling who is returning to the magnet school.


Sibling priority is the highest priority but is only applicable if the older sibling will be attending the same magnet school the next year.


Soccer
