Broughton High School's Walk for Water - As a global studies school, Oberlin values preparing students to "take action" to improve our global community. Broughton students are doing just that, and they have invited us to join. Global H2O, a 501(c)(3) organization based in Raleigh, North Carolina, provides clean water and sanitation facilities in rural areas of Africa, particularly in Uganda, to solve the water crisis and improve health, education, and community growth. Walk for Water will be held on

Saturday, May 10, from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. The event will consist of walking the track at Jack Spain Stadium, relay races, competitions, student activities, and more. All of the funds from the event will go toward providing clean water and sanitation facilities in Central Africa. A woman walks 3.7 miles just to get a jug of water and will make the same long journey back home. Our Walk for Water 1-mile goal is to raise \$4,000 for one latrine. Our 2-mile goal is to raise \$9,200 for one well. And our 3-mile goal is to raise \$12,500 for a well and a latrine. More information can be found at this link.
