Girls' Flag Football Game - The annual Oberlin Flag Football game will take place on Wednesday, June 12th. Participants have already been practicing with their respective coaches. Seventh and eighth grade students will attend the game with their teachers. We recommend that students wear sunscreen, and bring a hat / visor, along with a water bottle. Families of participants are also welcome to attend. We suggest that families bring their own chairs to be placed in the shade, as seating will be limited. There is no cost to attend this event.

Report Cards and EOG / EOC Scores - Report cards and EOG / EOC scores will be mailed to families in mid-June. Families can always check PowerSchool for students' end of year report card grades.

PowerSchool Summer Access - All students and parents will maintain access to Powerschool throughout the summer. Powerschool provides parents with information regarding bus transportation. Please note that throughout the summer, there will be many versions of schedules, teams, and teacher assignments. Families can and should expect changes throughout the summer, and no schedules will be final until "Schedule Pick Up" on Friday, August 23rd. (More information to come in August.) EOG Remediation / Readministration - If your student passes their English Language Arts, Mathematics, or Science (8th grade only,) class, but is non-proficient for their EOG / EOG, your student will be invited to remediation and a test readministration on June 12th and 13th. Should your child meet the criteria for our EOG / EOC Remediation and Readministration program you will receive an invitation for your child to attend the program after the EOG testing window closes for our school. For your planning purposes, the program dates for the end of the school year are: June 13 and June 14. Transportation will be provided, and breakfast and lunch will be available. Participating students are allowed to be "picked up" by parents at the conclusion of the readministration. **Families of eligible students will receive a School Messenger email and a paper invitation, via student backpack, on Monday, June 10th. Families of eligible students must confirm participation no later than Wednesday, June 13th.**

Athletics - If your rising seventh or rising eighth grade student is interested in trying out and /or participation in athletics, please plan ahead. All students must have an up to date physical, within one year of the athletic season for the sport they are trying out for, along with all completed forms in DragonFly. Additionally, students must be in good academic standing passing three of four core classes, with no more than 14 absences during the previous semester of school.
