


Single Subject Acceleration (SSA) - Is your child a good candidate for SSA? The Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) Board of Education defines acceleration as allowing a student to move through traditional educational organizations more rapidly, based on readiness and motivation. Single Subject Acceleration (SSA) is the practice of placing a student in a higher-grade level in one subject area. This type of acceleration is for the purpose of providing access to appropriately challenging learning opportunities in either math or English Language Arts.

Current K-7th grade students are eligible for SSA testing. For traditional calendar schools, SSA test requests can be submitted from Feb. 22-March 22 by filling out this <u>Google Form</u> or by completing this <u>form</u> and returning it to Angela Lucas (ajlucas@wcpss.net) at Oberlin Middle School.
