We are in our 2nd week of high school class registration and things are going really well! Currently, we have over 82% of our students signed up for classes! This is outstanding and helps show the discipline and eagerness for our students to take their education seriously and start off next year with an ideal schedule. If your student has not yet signed up, that's ok. As a reminder, the deadline for registration is 3/25 (next Friday). Please encourage your child to sign up for their courses if they have not done so. As always, please let me know if you have any questions!

Onsite Covid Testing at Oberlin - Registered students should report to room 1208 each Wednesday upon arriving at school. Registered families who no longer wish to participate should email ktraynor@wcpss.net and ask for their student to be removed from the testing list. (If your child has tested positive for covid 19 within the last 90 days, they should no longer be participating in the voluntary testing program. Early Check Out from School - If your student needs to be checked out early from school, please note the following.

- Send a signed note with your child indicating the time for pick up. Have your child stop by the main office in the morning to receive a pass to leave class at the assigned time. Your child can then leave class and wait in the office for pick up.
- If the child is not picked up 15 minutes after the time indicated on the note, the child will be returned to class with respect to supervision and to participate in learning.
- Only parents / guardians or emergency contacts can pick up students. **Those picking up students must have photo identification ready for review.**
- We do not allow student pick up after 2:30 each day as we are shifting into dismissal procedures. After 2:30, families must participate in daily dismissal procedures.
