Parking Rules and Regulations

- Students must register their vehicles. Students with proper registration may park their vehicles in assigned parking spaces.
 Parking in another lot or space is prohibited. Parking permits must be displayed on the inside rearview mirror post. Any vehicle not displaying their permit can be towed or booted.
- Students may not sell, sub-lease, or give their assigned parking spaces to other students.
 Students may not switch parking spaces with other students unless authorized by administration
 Students may only leave school during lunch with an off-campus pass, after school ends, or after being checked out
- No student parking is allowed in the school bus parking lot, faculty lots, visitor spaces, or other undesignated areas.
- 4. There will be no loitering in the parking lots in the morning or afternoon. All students must leave the parking area immediately upon parking their vehicle, and immediately upon going to the parking lot after school or during lunch.
- 5. The safe operation of motor vehicles is required. Vehicles must not travel in excess of 10 miles per hour on campus. All traffic laws apply. Seat belts are required for driver and ALL passengers. No squalling of tires or reckless driving is permitted. Vehicles should be parked front-end first. Backing into spaces is not permitted. Students who operate a motor vehicle on campus should fully understand their duties and responsibilities. Under School Board Policy 7170, students who violate parking regulations are subject to all or any of the following consequences:
- 6. Revocation of parking privilege without refund.
 - Ticketing
 - Booting, towing and storage of the vehicle, at owners' expense
 - Disciplinary action
 - Criminal charges as prescribed by law.
- 7. The fee established by the Board of Education for the current school year through First Quarter is \$ 170.00, through Second Quarter \$127.50, through Third Quarter, \$85.00, through Fourth Quarter, \$42.50
- 8. It should be understood that the basis for assessing a parking fee is to provide salary payments to security personnel. Therefore, as noted in #9 and #10 below, refunds will not be made during the year. Specifically, refunds will not be made under the following circumstances:
 - Voluntary withdrawal for school (drop-out)
 - Long-term suspension from school
 - School-based disciplinary action related to loss of parking
 - Cancellation of need for space (e.g., car sold, parents revoke driving privilege, car wrecked, etc.)

- 9. If a student holding an assigned parking space transfers within the system during the school year, he/she shall be assigned a space at the receiving school with no further payment of fees, assuming the original parking tag has been surrendered to the sending principal. If such a space is not available, a refund will be due as outlined in #7 above.
- 10. A replacement parking tag is \$10.00.
- 11. Handicapped students will be granted first priority for assigned parking. Seniors will be granted second priority. Juniors will be granted third priority and sophomores fourth.
- 12. Students are expected to comply with all directions of the security officer who will be assigned to the parking area and campus.
- 13. Students may not use their vehicles to illegally take themselves or other students off campus; violations may result in revocation of parking pass and/or lunch permit.
- 14. Parking a vehicle on campus is a privilege, not a right. Please review all parking regulations with your parents and call the school for clarification of any matter about which there are questions.
- 15. Failure to stop for security checking passes or evading security checkpoints will result in loss of parking privileges
