Access Sites Can:

- Provide you with friendly and compassionate service
- Assess your needs
- Assist you in coming up with creative solutions
- Assist you in figuring out what resources are available to you
- Provide referrals to shelters, if necessary
- Eliminate the need to constantly call shelters for bed space
- Connect you to other community resources such as food, clothing, and employment services

Access Sites Cannot:

- Provide immediate shelter or hotel vouchers
- Determine or guarantee eligibility of community resources
- Provide financial assistance
- Provide transportation or bus passes
- Act as landlords, housing providers, or housing navigators/locators
