Start with Coordinated Entry

Coordinated Entry is a starting point to help individuals and families experiencing a housing crisis access community resources.

Where do I start?

First, we work to understand your current housing situation. Access Sites (on the right) will be able to help you determine which resources you are eligible for and may work best for you.

What happens next?

Based on your discussion, the Access Site staff will help connect you with community resources or make a referral.
