River Bend teachers will be releasing lessons each Monday and Wednesday morning (beginning April 13, 2020) in all content areas for your students. Each teacher will post two assignments for the week. These posts may include videos, written assignments and directions, websites to explore, and other resources. These will be accessible at any time through Google Classroom, Canvas, or the teacher’s website.

All work will be monitored and assessed with feedback provided. Teachers will contact individual students regarding missing or incomplete assignments.

Students who receive services through an IEP or 504 plan will be contacted by the staff member who provides support. Special Education teachers will provide support and collaborate with teachers to ensure students’ continuous learning.

Some of you may wish to have additional activities for your student. There are approved resources available for you on the [Remote Learning Resource Site](#) provided by WCPSS. If students need help troubleshooting technology concerns, they can submit requests to an online help desk at [StudentTechHelp.wcpss.net](http://StudentTechHelp.wcpss.net) or by phone at 919-694-8100. We know that family schedules can look very different; therefore, we ask you to establish a schedule/routine that works for your family to ensure that students engage in three classes each day. For example, a student may participate in lessons for Science, Math, and PE one day and then ELA, Social Studies, and his/her elective the next day. A sample schedule is listed below. FINALLY, please let your teacher, counselor, or grade level administrator know if there are home situations which do not allow your student to participate in remote learning. We know that some of you are facing situations that simply do not make remote learning feasible at this time. We will work with you and offer support as best as we can.
