Message to Families

The PreACT provides you and your child with information that can help you select the right high school courses, think about ways to target areas for improvement, and even begin discussions about college and career.

PreACT helps identify:

- How a student is doing with the skills and knowledge required to succeed in college and beyond
- Areas where extra help or additional courses are needed
- Career possibilities that match the student's interests

Your child may choose to have their information shared with colleges and scholarship agencies when they take PreACT, which can help them get discovered for college recruitment and scholarship possibilities.

Practice with the ACT Test Experience

PreACT provides students with a structured testing environment similar to what they will experience when taking the ACT, ACT test-quality questions, and predictive scores on the familiar 1–36 scale. Practice testing with the timing, setting, and format of the ACT without the distractions you might face practicing at home.

The PreACT was designed to give accurate predictions of your performance on the ACT test. Try your best on the PreACT to know exactly how close you are to your ideal score.

PreACT includes multiple-choice questions in English, reading, math, and science. Your scores will reveal your current knowledge and skills in each area. Since you get to keep your PreACT test booklet, you can go back through the questions and compare your answers with the correct ones after you get your results. This can help you focus on critical areas for improvement. The PreACT student report will give you targeted ideas to work on based on your subject scores.
