Project Enlightenment Programs & Services

The Alice K. Burrows Parent Teacher Resource Center

Available for parents, teachers, and others interested in finding resources about young children, the Resource Center includes a lending library of books and videos, activity ideas and other materials concerning young children. Call **919-694-8990** for further information and hours.

Screening Program

Screening services are available for three- and four-yearold children when parents have a concern about their child's development. A screening consists of engaging activities for children that provide information for the parents on how their child is developing. Parents observe and also participate in the screening. Call **919-694-8993** for further information. All screening services are free of charge.

Two Demonstration Preschool Classrooms:

Two inclusive classrooms are located at Project Enlightenment. The use of best practices in early childhood education makes both of them excellent training sites for hundreds of educators and parents each year. Call **919-856-7774** for further information.

Teacher/Parent Consultation

Project Enlightenment provides consultation in early childhood classrooms around individual children. Teacher Parent Consultants (TPCs) address classroom difficulties with behavior, social development and learning for children enrolled in preschools and child care facilities in Wake County. Requests for consultation can be made by directors/teachers. In public school kindergartens and in collaboration with School Intervention Teams, TPC's provide support to parents/families of public kindergarten children.
