Policy Engagement: The opinions of our families are very important, and we want your feedback. In order to hear from you all regarding our Title 1 Family Engagement Policy we will:

- Work in conjunction with the WCPSS Office of Equity Affairs to hold several Family Academy workshops to share
 opportunities to gather clarification of academic content and how to best support your children. These

- Maintain a Family Engagement Committee, comprised of staff, family, and community members, that will serve as a group of leaders who provide support toward engagement of all members of the Dillard Drive Magnet Elementary School community, including the planning, review, and improvement of the use of Title 1 funds.
- Send a copy of the policy home, including a form where feedback can be provided.

Shared Responsibilities for High Student Achievement: The shared responsibility expectations are reflected and presented in our Home-School Compact. These expectations include responsibilities of Dillard Drive Magnet Elementary School staff and families alike and the necessary partnership between these two groups, which shall be enriched throughout the year by communications regarding student progress.
