Athens Advantage Time Student Guidelines

PURPOSE

Athens Advantage Time has been created to assist students who are struggling with concepts or who are missing assignments for their current courses. Students who owe their teacher missing work or those who have a current PowerSchool average below 80%, will remain in the classroom during the Athens Advantage Time period. Students who aren't missing any work and who have an 80% or higher course average <u>may</u> remain in their classroom <u>or</u> they can be released to an approved location.

FRESHMEN

During Quarter 1 and Quarter 3, all Freshmen will be required to remain in the Athens Advantage Time classroom during each Athens Advantage Time period. Their eligibility for release time will be evaluated following the end of Quarter 1.

STUDENTS ELIGIBLE TO BE RELEASED

Those students who have all of their work completed and have an 80% or above, should move quickly to one of the approved areas within the first five minutes of Athens Advantage Time. Students who are eligible to be released will need to remain in their chosen area until the end of the Athens Advantage Time period for that day.

APPROVED AREAS

- 1) Media Center: For students wishing to research on a computer, read silently, work on homework, and/or check out a book. The Media Center may have to close once it reaches capacity.
- 2) **Computer Lab in Room 2924:** For students wishing to use computers for school work or research on school appropriate sites. The Computer Lab may have to close once it reaches capacity.
- 3) **Cafeteria:** For students who wish to eat a snack from home, study with quiet to moderate talking levels, or wishing to socialize from a seated area.
- 4) **Cafeteria Courtyard:** For students who want to be outside, eat a snack from home, and socialize with moderate talking levels.
- 5) **Upper Gymnasium:** For students wishing to socialize with moderate talking levels, use their phones while seated in the bleachers, walk laps around the gym, or be more active.
- 6) **Auditorium:** For students who want to sit quietly, read silently, work on homework, talk in quiet talking levels, and use their phones.
- 7) **Club Meeting:** For students who are meeting in a Club-sponsored meeting.

UNAPPROVED AREAS

- 1) All other hallways and locations other than those listed above are off limits.
- 2) Students <u>ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS OR LEAVE THE BUILDING</u> during Athens Advantage Time.
