

## AFHS Promotion Requirements

Promotion to Grade 10: Minimum of six credits: One English credit; two credits in the areas of mathematics, social studies, and science; three additional credits to total six.

Promotion to Grade 11: Minimum of twelve credits: Two English credits (I \& II); one credit each in mathematics, social studies, and science; seven additional credits to total twelve.

Promotion to Grade 12: Minimum of eighteen credits: Three English credits (I, II, III); enrollment in the remaining courses needed to graduate.

| English | 4 | English I, II, III, IV |
| Mathematics | 4 | Math 1, 2, 3, and fourth math credit aligned with student's post- <br> high school plans* |
| Science | 3 | Earth Science or AP Environmental Science; Biology; one of the <br> following: Physical Science, Chemistry, Physics |
| Social Studies | 4 | World History or AP World; Civic Literacy or AP Government; <br> American History or APUSH; Economics \& Personal Finance** |
| Health \& PE | 1 | Healthful Living I |
| Required Electives | 2 | 2 electives of any combination from CTE, Arts, or World Languages |
| Other Electives | 8 | Courses from any area |
| TOTAL | 26 | Minimum required to graduate |

*Most four-year colleges and universities require one math credit beyond Math 3 (Math 4, Pre-Calculus, AP Statistics, Discrete Math for Computer Science)
