

## *Apex Friendship Social Studies Course Information*

### **Academic Classes:**

- \*Teachers provide direct instruction
- \*Homework is reviewed in class and students are provided with remediation
- \*Review for assessments is provided in class

### **Honors Classes:**

- \*Students learn independently with the guidance of direct instruction
- \*Work is assigned in class and outside of class
- \*Review for assessments is provided in class, but questions include a higher level of comprehension

### **AP Courses:**

- \*AP courses equate to a first-year college-level course; therefore, students may earn college credit for the course.
- \*In AP classes, students are expected to read and write at an advanced level.
- \*Students are expected to work outside of class to learn and practice the material
- \*Texts and supplemental readings are college level



### **Core Courses (these courses are required):**

**9th Grade:** World History (Academic/Honors) **or** AP World History

**10th Grade:** Civic Literacy (Academic/Honors) **or** AP Government

**11th Grade:** American History (Academic/Honors) **or** AP US History

**12th Grade:** Economics & Personal Finance (Academic/Honors)
