WHO? This program is for **young children 18 months through age 5** (*before Kindergarten eligible*) and their parent/caregiver.

WHAT? RTL centers are located in elementary schools throughout Wake County and provide parent-child interactive sessions that occur weekly. Sessions may include:

- Parent-Toddler Activities
- Parent-Child Developmental Play Groups
- “Getting Ready for Kindergarten” Activities
- Developmental Screenings
- Parent Education
- Referrals to Community Programs & Agencies

The program provides an opportunity for parents/caregivers to interact with their children in activities planned by a Ready to Learn Facilitator. Parents learn strategies to promote continued learning and development in a fun and engaging manner with their children at home.
