Information for Seniors Senior Turn-In Materials

1. Senior Exit Survey

2. Scholarship Reporting Form

All WCPSS high schools are required to report seniors' scholarships. Please fill out the <u>Scholarship Reporting Form</u> $\sqrt{2}$ with all your awards and scholarships so we can celebrate with you at Senior Awards Night on June 1st. The form must be completed and you must provide the financial aid letter on college/ organization letterhead to have the amount shared. This includes any scholarship you accepted and not accepted.



Per Fire Code, the family member assisting must remain within arm's length of the wheelchair.




