- All students should attend all class periods on January 21 & 22. Students in English II, Math I, &/or Math III will participate in a review on those days.
- All Students who do not have an EOC or make-up exam do not report to school on January 23, 24, or 27.
- The Biology EOC will be administered during the first two exam days. Students will take the Biology EOC during their normal class period.
- EOC, NCFE, & CTE Post Assessments count for 20% of a student's final grade for the course.
(English II scores will be delayed & will not count toward a student's final grade. Additional information will be shared through English teachers.)
- Students are expected to take exams during scheduled times. Students must be present from the beginning of the exam period, and must remain for the entire exam period.
- If absent from an exam, students must submit a note to the Attendance Office. Students are responsible for working with their teachers to schedule a date and time for their make-up exam.
- Students who remain on campus after EOC exams must remain in the designated, supervised areas.
- According to North Carolina testing policy, students are not allowed to bring electronic devices, other than approved calculators, into testing rooms. Any student who accesses an electronic device at any time during the exam period, including during breaks, will be dismissed from testing and a misadministration will be declared for that student. The student is also subject to disciplinary action.
- Under no circumstances can students be on other school campuses on exam days.
- Per Board Policy 6000, students are not eligible for exam exemption from exams with state testing requirements. This includes courses with North Carolina Final Exams, End-of-Course Exams, & CTE Post Assessments.
