### EXAM NOTES

- Students are expected to take exams at the scheduled times, must be present at the beginning of the exam period to take the exam and must remain for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
- If absent, submit a parent note to the Attendance Office upon return to school. The student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up exam date for teacher made and CTE exams. The Testing Coordinator will schedule make-up EOC & NCFE exams. All make-up state exams are given on computers.
- Students who do not have an EOC or make-up exam will not report to school June 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup>.
- All final exams will count as 20% of the final grade.
- According to North Carolina testing policy, students are not allowed to bring electronic devices (other than approved calculators) into the testing room at any time during state testing, including breaks. A student dismissed for a violation of the electronic device policy must take the missed exam on June 12<sup>th</sup>. Per WCPSS policy, the student is subject to disciplinary action by school administration.
- Buses will run on a regular schedule during exams. Students may not return to a class after they have taken the final exam. Under no circumstances can students be on other school campuses on exam days.
- Per Board Policy 6000, seniors are not eligible for exemption for courses with stat testing requirements, including North Carolina Final Exams (*Advanced Functions & Modeling, American History: Founding Principles, Civics & Economics, American History 1, American History 2, Chemistry, Discrete Mathematics, Earth/Environmental Science, English 1, 3 & 4, Math 2, Physical Science, Physics, Pre-Calculus and World History*), End of Course (*Biology, English 2, Math 1 & Math 3*) exams, and CTE Post Assessment .
