



## 2019 PSAT/NMSQT Information

The Wake County Public School System will offer the PSAT/NMSQT on  
**Wednesday, October 16, 2019**

The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized, multiple-choice test that includes three sections: critical reading, mathematics and writing. While all high school students and some middle school students may register to take the PSAT NMSQT, 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade students should visit the [College Board Website](#) for help in deciding if the PSAT/NMSQT is right for you. Scoring well on this exam is one of the criteria by which 11<sup>th</sup> grade students can qualify for a National Merit scholarship. For this reason, WCPSS is offering the test free of charge to 11<sup>th</sup> grade students with a weighted GPA of 4.3125 or higher. 11<sup>th</sup> grade students with a GPA below 4.3125 and all other students will pay the \$17 exam fee. Fee waivers are also available for students based on financial need. **All students will take the PSAT/NMSQT, not the PSAT 8/9 or PSAT 10.**

**New! COLLEGE BOARD STUDENT ACCOUNT:** Students should create a College Board account known as AP ID. This is a lifetime number for each student for all College Board related services (PSAT, SAT, AP). Visit: [myap.collegeboard.org](http://myap.collegeboard.org) to create an account. Students with existing accounts should log in to verify account information.

\*Online Payment can be made by clicking the "ONLINE PAYMENTS" under the PARENTS tab on the [GHHS Website](#), then selecting PSAT Registration. Please print and attach your receipt to the completed registration form. Online payment is preferred; however, checks made payable to Green Hope High School or exact cash will be accepted during the period specified above.

**The deadline to submit registration AND payment for the PSAT test is September 16<sup>th</sup>.** Students who are not registered by September 16<sup>th</sup> will not be permitted to take the exam. **11<sup>th</sup> grade students that qualify to take the exam at no cost will still need to complete and submit the registration form by the September 16<sup>th</sup> deadline.**

**MIDDLE & HOMESCHOOL STUDENTS:** Middle school students register with their local middle school. Homeschool students can test at the nearest WCPSS Middle or High School. Students choosing to test at Green Hope High School will register in the same method as current GHHS students.
