### **Family Involvement in Policy and Plan**

- Families will be invited and encouraged to participate in the Forest Pines Drive Family Engagement Committee.
- Families will work with the Forest Pines Drive teachers in an organized, ongoing, timely way to develop and review Family Engagement involvement and School-wide Plan.

### **Family Meetings**

- Forest Pines Drive Elementary's Family Engagement Committee will plan and coordinate two family meetings, one with a literacy focus and one with a math and science focus.
- Food and childcare will be provided for family meetings.
- Family meetings will include instructional supports (i.e. books) that will be provided to families at no cost.
- Interpreters will be provided as necessary to ensure equitable access to information.
- Communication about family meetings will be done through grade level newsletters, school messenger, and reminders sent home with students.

### **Communication with Families**

- Forest Pines Drive teachers will communicate with individual families about student progress on a continuous basis through ongoing contacts, parent/teacher conferences, newsletters, and other forms of written communication.
- Parents will be provided with information about assessments, grade level expectations, and the curriculum.
- Class information will be translated into home languages as much as possible.
- Interpreters will be coordinated by grade levels to facilitate communication during parent conferences and family educational events.
