GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - North & South Korea: On October 1, the two countries began their first joint demining effort in more than 10 years. As part of efforts to ease military tensions, North and South Korea will begin removing mines in symbolically significant locations in the demilitarized zone. Experts say there could be as many as 2 million mines left by both sides after the Korean War. Today, stray mines still cause deadly incidents when they are dislodged by swollen rivers and washed downstream into populated areas.
