The nomination window for our Broughton Capital Foundation's Jewell & Jenrette Teaching Excellence Awards is now open. The Richard Jenrette and Richard M. Jewell Teaching Excellence Awards are designed to promote, recognize and retain excellence in teaching at Broughton High School. These awards are presented to Broughton teachers/faculty who exhibit the highest caliber of the teaching profession. One Jenrette award will be presented for the 2018-2019 school year with a monetary value of \$3,000 . Up to five Jewell awards will be presented for the 2018-2019 school year with a monetary value of \$1,500 each.

- Nominees must have been part of the Broughton faculty for a minimum of three years.
 - Teachers, Counselors and Media Specialist are eligible.
 - Principals and Assistant Principals are not eligible.
 - Any teacher currently holding a Jenrette or Jewell Teaching Excellence Award is not eligible.
 - Nominations may be made by current and former Broughton students, parents, faculty and staff, or individuals may self-nominate.
 - An individual may submit more than one nomination.
 - All nominations are to be submitted to Elena Ashburn, Principal of Broughton High School. [Nominations can be submitted electronically by completing this survey form](#) or by emailing Principal Ashburn at eashburn@wcpss.net.
 - Nominations must be submitted to Principal Ashburn by Monday, December 3, 2018 at 4:00PM.



The Jenrette and Jewell Teaching Excellence Awards are based on the following areas of outstanding leadership in the classroom and school community:

- **Knowledge:** The recipient shall have a thorough knowledge of his or her subject and related general information.
- **Presentation:** The recipient shall present content in an interesting manner, using a variety of instructional approaches that stimulate students' desires to learn.
- **Classroom Environment:** The recipient shall create and maintain a positive learning atmosphere by being fair, friendly and firm.
- **Concern for the Individual:** The recipient shall respect and care for the students as individuals.
- **School Involvement:** The recipient shall demonstrate leadership through involvement in activities outside of the classroom and be supportive of the total school program.

The **North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics** has become the model for 18 such specialized schools around the globe. the **Residential Component** offers high school students the opportunity to live on campus for their junior/senior years and graduate from NCSSM. The **Online Component** offers high school students the opportunity to take online NCSSM courses during their junior/seniors **years while remaining enrolled at their home high school.** **Summer Ventures** offers high school students the opportunity to live on a college campus for 4-weeks during the summer of either the junior or senior year of high school. Interested students **are required** to take the SAT without essay in October, November, or December of their sophomore year. Applications for the Class of 2021 opened in October and will be accepted from 10th grade students through January 15, 2019.
