

ASVAB Career Assessment (November 9):

Have you ever thought about HOW YOU ARE SMART rather than how smart you are? Sometimes strengths cannot be identified in traditional tests, so get to know yourself and determine a career that is fulfilling! Take the ASVAB. This career assessment is FREE for students who are serious about their futures! Any Juniors or Seniors interested in joining the military must take the ASVAB entrance exam, but this test does NOT mean that you have to enter the military if you take the test. <u>Only 10th-12th graders are eligible to take the assessment</u>. The test will be given on Friday, November 9 at 7:25am in the Media Center. The complete test, including instruction time, takes about 3 hours. Students should report to the media center before 7:25 am and be prompt! Interested in Clemson University? Broughton has been asked to nominate high-achieveing 9th and 10th graders for the C-CATS Program, Clemson's Challenge for Academically Talented Students. The program is designed specifically for students expected to rank in the top 10% of their class and whose academic records predict a score of 1300 or higher on the SAT. Clemson will extend an invitation to the parents of each student nominated, asking them to consider sending their student to one of seven C-CATS weekends, March-May 2019. Since these weekend sessions will be personalized and provide hands-on experiences, each session will be limited to 50 students [25 males and 25 females]. Deadline: December 15.
