GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - Kazakhstan: Kazakhstan's population of critically endangered saiga antelopes has more than doubled since the last aerial survey in 2019, offering hope for the species' survival. The number of saiga antelopes, a steppe-dwelling creature known for its bulbous snout, rose from 334,000 to 842,000, according to the April survey. This comes after infection wiped out more than half of the global saiga population in 2015.
