GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS - United States: In Arizona, a small Tucson neighborhood is practicing permaculture on street after street to grow food with harvested rain. Dunbar Spring residents in 1996 started planting trees for shade that would be watered by captured runoff. Some 1,700 drought-tolerant native trees and thousands of specimens in the understory now help moderate air temperatures and provide food such as prickly pear fruit and goji berries. At a community event each summer, mesquite seeds are ground into flour.

From Trash to Treasure: Plastics and Sustainability

[Frank Leibfarth, Associate Professor, Department of Chemistry](#)

Thursday, October 19th, 6 – 7:30PM By the year 2050, there will be more plastic in the ocean than fish. What is UNC doing to address this problem? Frank Leibfarth is leading research efforts to turn plastics into useful materials. Enough plastic pellets are produced in the world each day to fill a modern football stadium. While plastic improves our quality of life in countless ways, we are beginning to realize the significant environmental and societal cost of plastic waste. This lecture will provide a history of plastic production, how it is essential to modern society, and what innovations are needed to move towards a more circular plastics economy.
