The **Online Component** offers high school students the



opportunity to take online NCSSM courses during their junior/seniors **years while remaining enrolled at their home high school. Summer Ventures** offers high school students the opportunity to live on a college campus for 4-weeks during the summer of either the junior or senior year of high school. Interested students **are required** to take the SAT without essay in October, November, or December of their sophomore year. Applications for the Class of 2021 opened in October and will be accepted from 10th grade students through January 15, 2019.
